Under-10 Go-games will commence on Sat 3rd May 2008.

The proposal for this year's games is based largely on last years' framework with some changes as recommended by the clubs' u-10 coaches. The main changes are that:

1. For 9-a-side games a goalkeeper should be employed. This gives a 1 – 3 – 2 – 3 structure, which is a more accurate miniature of a 15 a side game. This causes less confusion when moving between small sided and 15 a side games.
2. There will be 3 points for over the bar, 1 point for a goal.
3. Players are restricted to '1 bounce and 1 toe-tap' or '2 toe-taps'.

On occasion larger clubs may be paired with 2 smaller clubs on the same day. As before, communication between coaches before hand will let everyone know how to divide up teams to give all players football.

Layout

A and B teams maximum aside.

C teams 5-9 aside.

The 3 game take place on 1 pitch.

Referees

Home and away coaches ref A and B games

Home coach for C match

Points

Award points for own clubs benefit, i.e. award something at end of year
3pts – win, 2pts – draw, 1pt – loss.

A + B scores counted only.

Time

4 x 10 min Quarters (change ends with quick water break)

5mins break after 2nd quarter

Rules

Proper pick-up

All kicks from hands

45s taken from half-way

'1 bounce + toe-tap' or '2 bounces'

3pts for over the bar, 1pt for goal

Players removed from play for bad language or indiscipline

This player can be replaced, but cannot return later

All rules applying to coaches, parents and supporters come under the auspices of the GAA Official Guide

After Games

Line-up and shake hands with the opposition and mentors

Preparation

Clubs should co-operate on all matters of preparation, particularly bringing goalposts.

Clubs should have structures in place to make sure the manpower is available for the successful implementation of these Go-Games.
